Choose the perfect color palette with confidence by embracing color theory. Understanding the relationship between different colors can help you use color more effectively in your ceramic arts. Whether is personal preference or a feeling you wish to evoke, try combining colors using these key color theories:

ANALOGOUS - Three colors that are next to each other in the color wheel; these color combinations can often be found in nature.

COMPLEMENTARY - colors directly opposite each other in the color spectrum, creating a strong contrast.

HARMONY - pleasing to the eye and work well together.

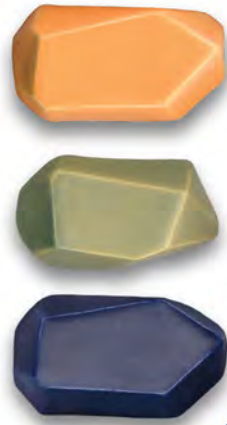
MONOCHROMATIC - Having only one color represented by different hues and tints. You can get the same effect by grouping colors within the same color family. Color families are a division of the color wheel into warm, cool and neutral colors.
