INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

DESCRIPTION

Like all Cromartie equipment the Clay Roller is a well designed and sturdy machine. The basic framework is of electrically welded steel and the roller is manufactured from aluminium alloy. The bearings used are sealed for life and do not require any regular maintenance.

INSTALLATION

Unpack the slab roller ensure that nothing is damaged, if there is report it immediately to the person you purchased the machine from.

The slab roller will normally be delivered pre-assembled if not please follow assembly instructions.

Limited 2 Year Warranty

Cromartie Hobbycraft Limited warrants to the original purchaser of new products only, (this warranty is not transferable) that this product is free from materials or workmanship defects under normal use, This is a one year parts and labour primary warranty, an extended parts only warranty for a second year is available upon registration (this warranty does not cover consumables) and all products are properly maintained for 2 years from the date of Invoice.

Exclusions & Limitations

The following are examples that are not covered by, and / or circumstances that will void the warranty. Any damages or loss caused by the following, improper operation due to failure to follow instructions within the manual, natural disaster, fire, misuse, overload, accident, improper storage, inadequate maintenance or negligence, freight damage failure to report any defect within 15 days after it becomes manifest or known, servicing by anyone not approved by Cromartie, or persons acting under direct authorisation of Gladstone, any alteration of parts or design that vary from the factory design, use any parts other than genuine parts supplied by Cromartie, repair or alteration by anyone other than Cromartie or their approved agent. This warranty is strictly limited to repair or replacement of defective parts, items may not be returned for refund or exchange, transport costs must be borne by the customer. Agents and distributors are not author ised by Cromartie to modify and/or assume any other obligations or liabilities other than expressed in this limited warranty and any such additional obligations are null and void. Any statements made by Cromartie's agents or representatives do not constitute warranties. At the end of the one year Primary Warranty, all labour and travelling costs will be invoiced and are payable by the customer. Cromartie shall not be responsible for any work carried out on the products without the buyer first getting written permission from Cromartie. Cromartie shall not be liable for any incidental or consequential damages including bodily injury or death, lost profits, loss of use or other economic losses of any kind arising directly or indirectly by or resulting from the goods or their use by the buyer or any third party or from any services provided by Cromartie. Repair or their replacement of the product shall Not extend the warranty period. This warranty constitutes the Sole and Exclusive Warranty. Cromartie hereby disclaims all other warranties, expressed, statutory or implied, applicable to the product, including but not limited to, all implied warranties of merchantability for fitness. The Buyer must have Cromartie's written authorisation before returning the product, properly packaged, freight prepaid to Cromartie to obtain warranty service. Under this warranty Cromartie's Sole Obligation shall be to repair or replace the defective product or part at Cromartie's discretion. Gladstone reserves the right to satisfy this warranty by reimbursing all payments made to Cromartie where upon all title shall pass to Cromartie upon acceptance of the returned product. All products must be returned to Cromartie before credit or replacement can be given. The Buyer is solely responsible for ensuring that the goods brought from Gladstone are fit for any particular purpose and no warranty or conditions of fitness for purpose is given or is to be implied in these terms. The terms of this warranty does not affect your statutory rights.

Assembly instructions

Get an assistant to hold the slab roller on its end while you attach the legs. Once both legs are fixed into

position fix the tie bar between the two sets of legs. Attach the hand wheel by lining up the square key way with the slot in the hand wheel, push the hand wheel on and then tighten the securing pin.

OPERATION

The thickness of the slab is governed by adjusting the height of the roller above the table. This is done by releasing the two large clamping knobs on either side of the roller and turning the centre adjusting knob positioned over the roller to raise or lower the roller to the required depth, there is a printed scale to act a visual guide for the thickness of Clay required, <u>re-tighten the clamping knobs on either side before using</u>. Wind the larger roller to the end of the bed where the cloths are fitted, lift the top cloth over the roller place a suitable amount of clay in the middle of the bed and wind the roller over the clay and back again to form a clay slab.

<u>NOTE</u>

DO NOT OVERLOAD the slab roller or put undue pressure on the hand wheel as this could damage the unit.

MAINTENANCE

Periodically check that all the nylon wheels are in contact with the clayroller frames. Any slack can be taken up by releasing the top central wheel and pushing it downwards.

Apply a small amount of grease onto the drive chains at quarterly intervals and check that all nuts and bolts are tight.

DO NOT MACHINE WASH THE CLOTHS. If the cloths need cleaning sponge wash them with water and a mild detergent and allow them to air dry.
